# How are we Spiritually Transformed?

<sup>1</sup> Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.

# What are Spiritual Gifts?

Romans 12:6-8: Prophecy/exhortation, service, teaching, encouraging, giving, leadership, mercy

I Corinthians 12:8-10, 28 (besides the ones in Romans) wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, miraculous powers, discernment, tongues, interpretation of tongues, apostle, healing, helps, guidance

Ephesians 4:11 (besides those mentioned above) evangelist, pastor

# What are Spiritual Gifts?

Every believer has been given at least one spiritual gift  
(1 Peter 4.10).

The Holy Spirit is the one who decides who gets what gift  
(1 Cor. 12.11).

The gifts are intended to help us serve **OTHERS**  
(1 Cor. 12:7).
